

# Where in the world is the Abel Tasman Lodge?

We are 400 metres from the Abel Tasman National Park southern entrance. The Lodge is clearly signposted at the front of the property, drive down to park and see us at reception.

### **Physical Address**

295 Sandy Bay–Mārahau Rd, Mārahau

## **Driving from Picton, Nelson and West Coast**

Take the road to Motueka. Drive through the small settlement of Riwaka.

Continue on the main road (SH60) heading towards Abel Tasman National Park (these are highlighted using brown signs).

When you arrive at the T intersection you turn left and then immediately right (follow green Mārahau 9 km sign).

This area is well signposted – you are looking for a green Mārahau 10 km sign / Abel Tasman National Park (brown sign).

Do not go via Kaiteriteri. Warning, it's a very curvy road!

Come over the Mārahau hill and follow the road onto the beachfront.

### **Drive Times & Distances**

16 km (10 miles) from Motueka – 20 minutes

60 km (40 mi.) from Nelson Airport – 50 minutes

200 km (125 mi.) from Picton Ferry – just under 3 hours

244 km (150 mi.) from Westport – 3.5 hours

282 km (175 mi.) from Punakaiki – 4 hours
